### The Power of an Invite:

Why people came to church:

6-8% Came by own initiative

8-10% Liked the clergy

3-4% Had a need met by the church

1-2% Were evangelized

75-85% Were invited by a friend

The average is that 83% of people came to church because a friend invited them to come.

#### 2023 Donation Reminder and Information


